As an introduction to the two Reading Together selections, *The Souvenir: A Daughter Discovers Her Father's War* by Louise Steinman, and *The Things They Carried* by Tim O'Brien, two local writers will share their own war-related experiences and writings.

In connection with Steinman's memoir, the Reverend Edgar Peara of Eugene, a WW II vet who served in Europe, Africa, and then in Okinawa and the occupation of Korea (Korean War), will share from his editorial essays.

Kim Findling Cooper, a freelance writer from Bend, will share from her essay "Witnessing" (Oregon Quarterly, Winter 2006) about her experiences accompanying her father, a Vietnam veteran, to an Army reunion in Texas in 2004.
