 - Writing and College Math (requirements for AAOT & transfer to 4-year university).
 - Foreign language (transfer path only): 2 years in high school or 2 terms in college.

 - Mus 101/131 path (non-major path)
 - Music Theory path (AS Music and AAS): Music placement test is required.
