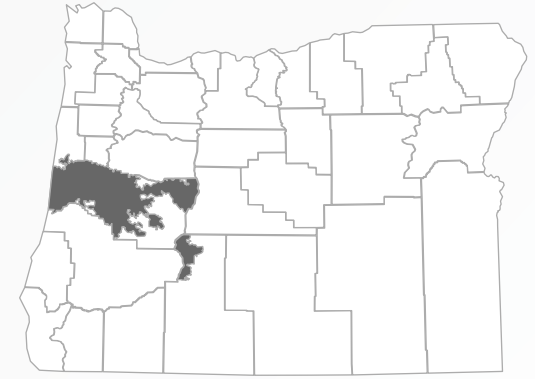

## Economic impact analysis

**Alumni impact**  
*Impact of the increased earnings of Lane alumni and the businesses they work for*

**\$554.7 million** Added income

**7,502** Jobs supported

An economic boost similar to hosting the Super Bowl **OR**

**1** out of every **24** jobs in the Lane Service District is supported by the activities of Lane and its students.

**Operations spending impact**  
*Impact of annual payroll and other spending*

**\$100.3 million** Added income

**1,039** Jobs supported

Enough to buy **2,130** new cars **OR**

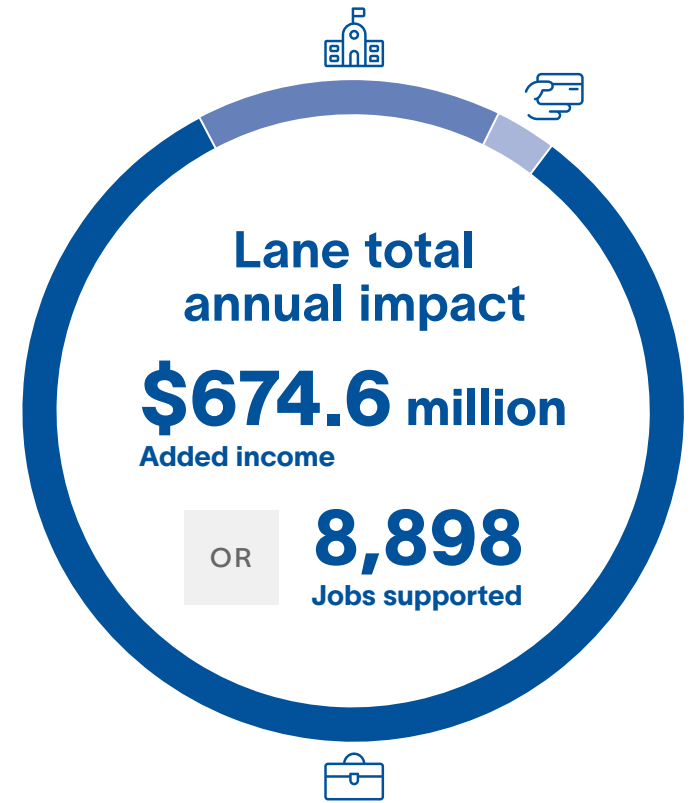
**Student spending impact**  
*Impact of the daily spending of Lane students attracted to or retained in the region*

**\$19.7 million** Added income

**357** Jobs supported

Enough to buy **1,592** families\* a year's worth of groceries **OR**

● = 100 jobs \* = family of four



## Investment analysis

For every \$1...

**Students** gain **\$4.80** in lifetime earnings

**Taxpayers** gain **\$1.10** in added tax revenue and public sector savings

**Society** gains **\$5.80** in added income and social savings

The average associate degree graduate from Lane will see an increase in earnings of **\$7,900** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Oregon.
