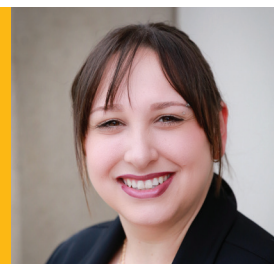
### Jennifer | Business Management Student
